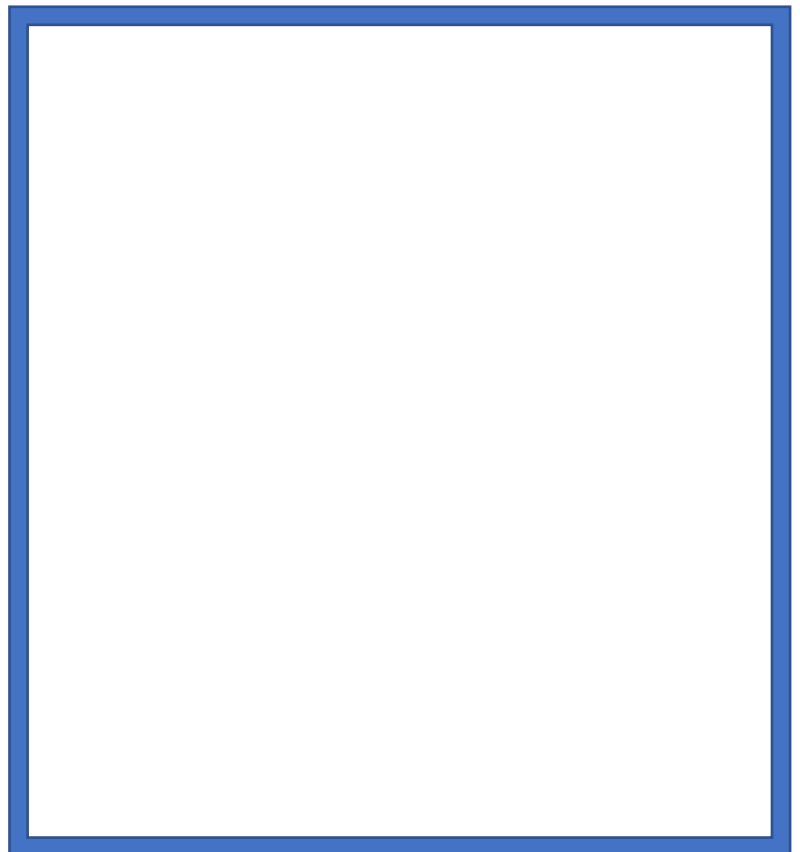


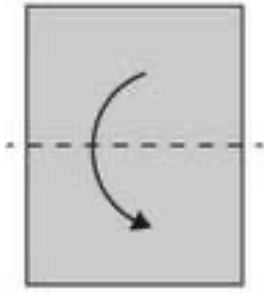
There are instructions for making your own origami boat – I wonder if you can make it be in a ‘storm on the sea’ once you have made it?

### Challenge for this week:

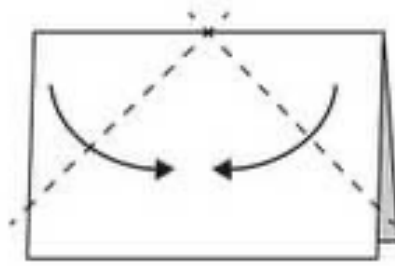
Remember that when someone trusts you with something special they are choosing to be vulnerable – make sure that you show that you treat that specially.

The Bible tells us that Jesus chose to make himself vulnerable because he loves us... think about how you feel about that idea. Maybe you could write down something of how it makes you feel.

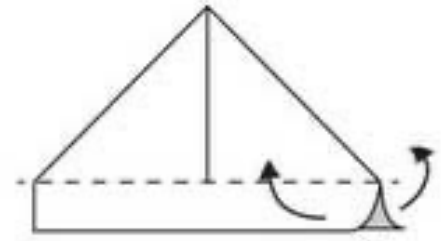




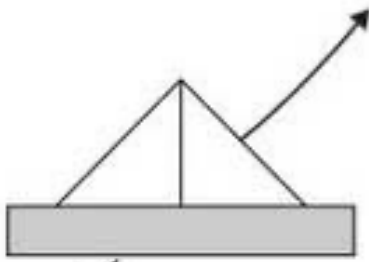
1. Fold paper

in half



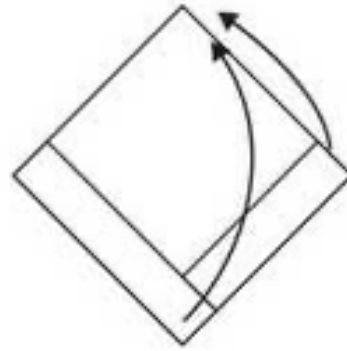
2. Fold corner in



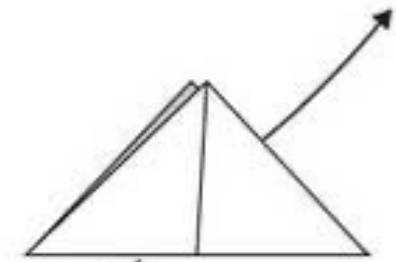
3. Fold along bottom  
on both sides



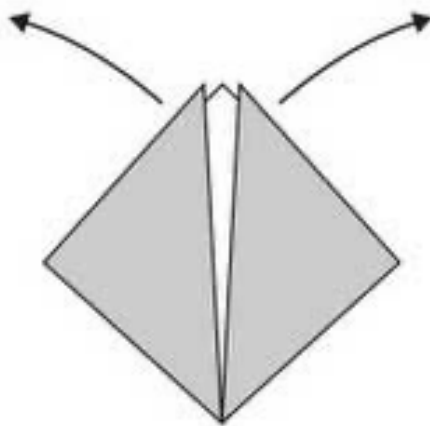
4. Lift the

sides together



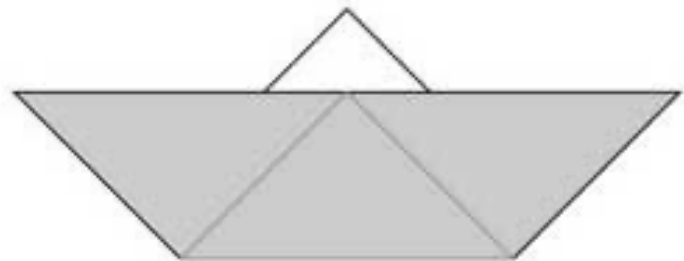
5. Fold bottom
