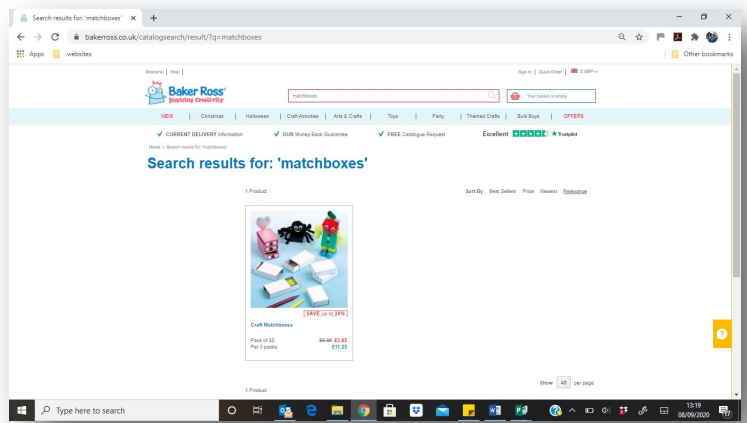


How to make mini-Bibles

You will need to pre-order matchboxes for each child. Baker Ross sell them in packs of 30 costing you about 13p per child. Bakerross.co.uk They take less than a week to be delivered usually.

You will also need black card cut into rectangles big enough to wrap around 3 sides of the match-box and leaving a couple of millimetres around the edges. Or any colour thin card of course!

And glue and strips of white paper for inside.



Children can choose a favourite Bible verse for the middle or draw a cartoon version of a Bible story to put inside. Gold and silver pens make writing on the cover easier and can be used on the "spine" to create that fancy Bible look!
