Teacher guide

The video has moments at the end of each section which say 'Pause to Wonder'. You may (you know your classes) wish to actually pause the video at this moment for pupils to discuss what they have seen/their thoughts.

You may choose to follow it in sections, in which case these are the sections and their length:

The start of the story: 11 mins 30

Visiting Mary: 1 minute

The dark field: 2 minutes 10

In the stable: 6 minutes

The wise man's house: 2 minutes 40

The second beginning: 9 minutes

In the 'start of the story' there is mention of favourite animals/plants. Again, you may wish to pause the video to allow pupils to discuss their favourites before I give some suggestions in the video.

The worksheet can be done whilst watching, or afterwards, but is intended to give pupils an opportunity to reflect on their own thoughts.

The extension questions require some research, but these do have 'right answers'.

Extension question answers: The dove was the Holy Spirit.

Gold – given to royalty, kingly. Frankincense – used in the worship of God. Myrrh – used for healing or at burial. Examples of parables: The lost sheep, the lost coin, the lost son, the good Samaritan, the yeast, the tenants, the pearl, the sower, the weeds, the hidden treasure, the talents, the wise and foolish builders...
