News from Ruth



A look back ... During September and October I have continued with my ongoing regular commitments for Collective Worship at All Saints, Flimby, Broughton and Crosscanonby Primary Schools and am actively involved in finding other ways I can support and resource them. Additionally, I have also supported the monthly Messy Church at Christ Church Cockermouth and the Family Service at Flimby, both of which are good for building relationships with the

children and local church folk. These contacts have led to conversations which have opened up new opportunities for me to work with churches as they connect with their local schools, including 'Experience Harvest' at Paddle School and at Dean Church. I have worked with the Workington Puppet Team on a Harvest/Thankfulness themed assembly which we took to Moor Row Primary School and St Michael's Infants' School in Workington. This assembly was also used as the focus for the October Messy Church

(Christ Church), working alongside the church team. At Crosscanonby Primary School I have also continued to develop classroom Prayer Space activities.

A look forward ... The next half term will be busy. As well as my regular Collective Worship sessions and Prayer Spaces, there will be a focus on preparing for Christmas. Activities in the planning so far –

- 'Christmas Journey' at Bassenfell Manor (21 school groups over 7 days)
- 'Experience Christmas' at All Saints Church, and others to be confirmed.
- 'Christmas in a Box' at Crosscanonby Primary School.
- A Christmas Assembly, working with the Workington/Copeland Puppet Team, for Mayfield, Westfield, Flimby, Moor Row, St Michael's, Lowca and Parton Schools.
- Filming the Allerdale Puppet Team and making a video version of their Christmas Assembly to circulate to schools.
- Outreach events at Cockermouth and Workington Christmas Lights Switch-Ons and Emmanuel Church, Moor Row.

What is "Christmas in a Box"? It is a small scale version of "Experience Christmas", which can be used with groups of children in their classroom. They unpack 6 boxes which each contain a collection of props that relate different parts of the Christmas Story. There is space to pause and wonder, plus a creative activity which facilitates reflection and discussion. As children explore the boxes they are able to learn more about the significance of the birth of Jesus both to the people who were there, and to Christians who follow him today.

<u>Allerdale</u> will be presenting five live assemblies in three schools, and hopefully be able to send out a video version to our other schools.

Members from all three teams will be involved in outreach over the Christmas period: The Christmas Lights Switch-on at the URC Church in Cockermouth; the Christmas Lights Switch-on in Workington; and Christmas Messy Church at Cockermouth Christian Centre held at the Ark.
