

EXCITING NEWS Although the 1-2-1 Listening Service is such a great tool for actively demonstrating the love of God, the out-working of the service often seems to be quite a battle and it can feel like, "One step forward and two (or more!) steps backwards!"

> I have now been in post for just over a year and it has been pointed out to me that all other NISCU areas and schools workers have a 'Support Group'.

> These groups support the local schools workers in discussing strategy and, most importantly, by praying for them and the work they are doing. I believe, along with Nick and the trustees, that if I had this sort of support, many of the frustrations that occur would be more readily overcome with prayer support.

So, I am now in the process of establishing a support group and looking forward to reporting new breakthroughs in the Spring 2023 newsletter.

- The 1-2-1 Listening Service in Cockermouth (West Cumbria area) and Morecambe (North Lancs area) continues to go well. There has been positive feedback from the staff, the volunteers and the pupils. It is so encouraging when the children come up to you and enthusiastically ask, "When is it my turn to come and talk to you?"
- As seems to be 'par for the course' with the 1-2-1 Listening Service, there were unforeseen delays to the proposed training in South Lakes, mentioned in the Summer newsletter, but Nick, Diana (S. Lakes schools' worker) and I had a great evening at The Lakes Christian Centre, talking about NISCU in general and the 1-2-1 Listening Service specifically. New volunteers have signed up to do the training in the new year which anyone can join if they are happy to travel to Windermere!
- We have 2 new volunteers looking at doing the 1-2-1 Listening Service in a secondary school in North Lancs.
- Amanda (NISCU Finance Administrator) and I had a very productive meeting with Ivan from the Kendal Foodbank, getting very helpful advice with regard to future funding applications.
