To be candid, we are entering a critical time in the life of the 1-2-1 Listening Service, as current funding for the service finishes in August. This has meant a significant proportion of my time this term has been spent researching and submitting funding applications and, as yet, without success. Seeing how effective and loved the service is in the schools in which it currently operates, it would be easy to allow panic and fear to set in, but we serve a God who is bigger than any obstacle we face and the Listening Service belongs to Him, the God who is "able to do immeasurably, abundantly more than we could ask or imagine." (Eph 3:20)

Autumn Update

- The service continues being a valued part of school life in West End Primary,
 N. Lancs and All Saints CE Primary , W. Cumbria.
- Since September, the service is up and running at a high school in N. Lancs, where we have 3 volunteers going in weekly - and the Head of Wellbeing said we provide a better service than some of the paid-for services!
- The service has been up and running in St Martin's and St Mary's, S. Lakes, since October, where we now have 2 listeners going in weekly
- The Service is 'going live' at The Lakes School, S. Lakes, this January, with 4 volunteers getting involved there.
- Many enquiries have been made regarding funding, 4 funding bids have been submitted, 2 of which have been rejected, so far.
